Executive Summary:

Hay, Brecon and Talgarth Sanctuary for Refugees (HBTSR) formed in September 2015.

HBTSR is a voluntary organisation welcoming people seeking sanctuary and raising funds to help them.

As a group, HBTSR supporters are of all faiths and not affiliated with any political persuasions: what unites them is their common humanity and compassion for others. One of their aims is to provide short-term respite and sanctuary for refugees in the peaceful countryside in and around the Brecon Beacons National Park

HBTSR is hosting a Welcome Day on Sunday 15th September and is fundraising to support the event with essential elements ensuring a successful event.

The Welcome Day includes encouraging new and existing refugees and local communities to meet and engage in multi-cultural events throughout the day, creating a safe and welcoming space for all.

Recommendation:
