DYFED-POWYS LOCAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE DELIVERY PLAN OVERVIEW 2025-2029

'TACKLING VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN, DOMESTIC ABUSE AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE (VAWDASV)' AND 'CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE' ARE TWO GOLDEN THREADS ACROSS ALL PRIORITIES

Priority 1 - Victims and Witnesses

1. Compliance with the Victims' Code of Practice (VCOP)- oversight of how well the CJS (Criminal Justice System) is meeting the needs of victims.
 - Local Criminal Justice Board (LCJB) will receive areas of concern/escalation
 - LCJB will receive highlights from witness experience surveys and victims voice feedback – what's working and issues raised about justice system
2. Victims of domestic abuse will receive better support as part of the new approach being piloted in the family courts.
 - Pathfinder pilot will be monitored to ensure an improved victim and children's experience of family court
3. Continue to bring together a picture of the criminal justice performance for rape victims across Wales
 - Monitor the uptake and impact of victim engagement with VLOs (Victim Liaison Officers) and pre-trial meetings

Priority 2 - People who offend

1. Out of Court Diversionary Activities - Monitor
 - Offender diversionary scheme
 - Drug diversion
 - Drug test on arrest and custody interventions
2. Understanding and addressing the criminogenic needs of our cohorts
 - Further analysis of data
 - Reducing reoffending in the complex needs cohort
 - Continued rollout of naloxone across Dyfed-Powys Police and partners
 - Improve offender housing accommodation as highlighted by the criminogenic needs of all our cohorts.
3. Improved management of VAWDASV perpetrators
 - Introduce a MATAC (Multi Agency Tasking and Co-ordination) process – risk assessing and managing offenders
 - Monitor the implementation and utilisation of CARA (Cautioning and Relationship Abuse) programme for DA (Domestic Abuse) perpetrators
 - Monitor the performance of the Regional VAWDASV perpetrator programme and consider the interventions required for offenders of sexual violence
4. Community Payback
 - Develop a shared communication strategy to promote the schemes
5. Restorative Justice
 - Ensure that victims have access to Restorative Justice at all stages of the criminal justice system (in line with VCOP)
6. Support the work of the Women's Justice Blueprint
