



DYFED SUBSTANCE MISUSE

Operating in Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion, and Pembrokeshire, Dyfed Drug and Alcohol Service (DDAS) aims to reduce substance misuse-related harm to service users, significant others and the wider community. DDAS also works to identify and engage offenders from the point of arrest through to sentence, and to maximise the proportion of individuals reducing their substance use and offending behaviour.

Contract held by: DDAS (Barod in consortium with G4S and Kaleidoscope)


Contract length: 1/5/2020 - 31/3/2025

Value of the contract: PCC contribution £215,000 pa (total contract value £1.52m per annum jointly commissioned with the Area Planning Board)

STATISTICS

During 2022/23, a total of 956 criminal justice referrals were made to the Dyfed Drug & Alcohol Service. 51% of service users exited the service positively; either drug free or met their target goal.


Top 5 substances being used:




Gender Split:
