**Title:** Poppit Sands Surf Lifesaving Club donation

**Executive Summary:**

In recognition of the voluntary work with the young people of St Dogmaels and surrounding areas, it has been proposed that a donation is offered to Poppit Sands Surf Lifesaving Club as a thank you for their proactive and positive activity.

The club provides opportunities for children and young people of the area to develop skills linked to life saving and water safety.

Nippers (7-12), Juniors (13-17), Seniors (18-29) and Masters (30+) train throughout the year - in the pool, on the beach and in the sea. Members of all ages develop fitness levels, practice rescue techniques and first aid, including CPR, which culminates in various accredited qualifications.

In 2023, the Club hosted the Welsh Nipper Championships at Poppit Sands and were awarded Nipper Club of the Year by the Surf Lifesaving Association of Wales.

Sadly, there was a tragic death last year and members of the club saved others involved in the incident.

The service supports Priority 2: Harm is prevented of the Police and Crime Plan.

**Recommendation:**

That the PCC provides a donation of £500 to Poppit Sands Surf Lifesaving Club from the Sale of Found Property Fund.
