These notes provide a summary of discussions and actions set.

1. Welcome and Overview

The PCC welcomed Select Committee members, reiterated the purpose of the Select Committee review, and of this meeting: To run through the findings of the draft report, its recommendations, and next steps for the review.

The PCC reflected on the news regarding the abolishment of PCCs, and how this may affect the impact this review can have.

2. Report findings and recommendations

Working Group members presented each recommendation in turn, providing details of the report findings and evidence which led to the drafting of the recommendation.

Select Committee members discussed each recommendation, proposing some changes to wording, as well as additional recommendations/areas of focus.

Action 18: Working Group to update report and appendices document as per Select Committee discussions and recirculate to Select Committee members.

Select Committee members discussed the governance structure around the ownership of, and progress against, recommendations.

It was proposed that a Roundtable Discussion is held, chaired by the PCC, where key stakeholders are asked to attend to discuss the recommendations; whether they are fair and justifiable, and the possible governance structure for the review's recommendations.

Action 19: Working Group to co-ordinate a Roundtable Discussion.

3. Next Meeting/Hearing

As per the action set by the PCC, the Select Committee will next meet as part of a multi-agency Roundtable Discussion, in-person, on a date to be determined.
