Title: Donation to The Wilderness Trust (Wales) Ltd

Executive Summary:

A request for funding was received from The Wilderness Trust (Wales) Ltd to support their project: Youth Resilience – The Big Gig for 16 -18 year olds.

A pilot evening event with local entertainment was organised last year in Llanidloes for 16-18 year olds. This was an alcohol free event involving workshops to learn about staying safe from drink spiking, sexual health, healthy relationships, driving safely and recognizing laws and social frameworks as teenagers venture into adulthood. This was supported and attended by local Statutory Bodies including Police, Health and Fire Services.

Following on from last years' success, The Wilderness Trust are organising another event during Autumn 2025 with the same Statutory organisations, providing young people with a safe space to enjoy each others' company and have access to information to build responsible, safe and respectful behaviours.

This project supports the Police and Crime Plan priority of Preventing Harm.

Recommendation:

To provide a donation of £500.00 from the Sale of Found Property Fund as a contribution to the project costs.
